#### **Welcome & Introductions**

The Ritchie Park Elementary School PTA President Debra Schaffer opened the second meeting of the school year.

## Safety and Security Briefing by school administration

- School administration showed the MCPS safety video about Avoid/Deny/Defend strategy

- Request for the school community to complete post-briefing survey LINK
  - The surveys are brief and anonymous. Information provided will only be connected to the school where the lesson occurred.

#### Questions:

- What content is shared with younger students?
  - No video is shared with younger kids, they practice the Avoid drill.
  - Six-graders watch the video
- How often does a school resource officer stop by?
  - Occasionally, by request introduces himself to students
- What about the reunification procedure?
  - Parents fill their information and who they are picking up, school administration has emergency contact information to verify
- How are schools alerted about the emergency?
  - Administration gets phone alerts and make decisions independently, can consult with central office if necessary
- Do students get drills on emergency when they are not in the classroom

 Yes, school practices reverse emergency drills, i.e. when students need to come back to school in case of a weather emergency

  - Code for online orders to be shared closer to the event


#### **PTA Membership Drive**

Results of the September membership drive:
